Leviticus 16:21: He is to lay both hands on the head of the live goat and confess over it all the wickedness and rebellion of the Israelites—all their sins—and put them on the goat's head.

v34 “This is to be a lasting ordinance for you: Atonement is to be made once a year for all the sins of the Israelites.”

No goat can remove sin and guilt; only God can do that.

1 Tim 2:5-6 “For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all men - the testimony given in its proper time.”

Jesus stands WITH us and FOR us.

He is at the right hand of God interceding for us - Romans 8:34.

Hebrews 4:15-16 “For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet was without sin. Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.”

He is able to sympathize with our weaknesses – meaning, He knows.
And He tells the Father, **“I’ve paid it all.”**
